With over 15 years as an MTCBA member, John has shown unwavering dedication and competitive excellence throughout his career.

John has made a significant mark in the City Tournaments, earning **six Team Championships**, a **Doubles title in 1998**, an **All-Events title in 1989**, and two **MTCBA Masters Championships in 1984 and 1988**. His talent extends beyond local events, with **State Championships in Team (2009)** and All-Events, as well as **three NEBA Championships**.

Regionally, John's impressive accomplishments include **two New Hampshire Champlain Singles titles**, two All-Events titles, one **CCBA Team title**, and an outstanding **six Cove Team titles**. His scoring record speaks volumes, with **32 perfect 300 games**, **10 800 series**, and well over **100 scores in the 700 range**.

John's remarkable consistency is further highlighted by his scoring averages, having maintained an average between **200-209 five times**, **210-219 five times**, and **220-229 four times** over his career.
