Tournament Rules

1. This tournament will be governed by USBC rules, MTCUSBC bylaws, and as hereafter set forth.
2. Mail-in or walk-in tournament. Mail-in entries must be post marked by June 8, 2025. No checks or credit cards accepted at the tournament site. **Cash only.**
3. All youth entrants must bowl in a MTCUSBC center / league and hold a current USBC Membership card and youth bowlers must not have reached the age of 18 as of Aug 1, 2024. Adults must have a valid current USBC card.
4. Format – 4 Game Scotch Doubles. (Youth throws the first shot in the first frame. If he/she strikes, the first frame is complete and the adult bowls the second frame. If the youth doesn't strike, the adult must get up to shoot the spare. The youth would then throw the first shot again in the second frame. Every shot should be alternated between youth and adult. The youth will start the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> game and the adult will start the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> game.)
5. Average: Adults will use their highest verifiable USBC 2024-25 regular league average based on 21 games or more. If none, a 2023-24 league average based on 21 or more games can be used. All others bowl scratch – 240 average. Tournament director reserves the right to rerate any bowler or assign averages where enough Information is presented.
6. Handicap for the series will be as follows: handicap will be based on a team basis. 90% of the difference of the team average and 480 for 2 games each.
7. There will be TWO (2) divisions; based on the youth's age. NOTE: tournament director reserves the right to cancel/merge any divisions in any event.
  - A – Handicapped Youth Age 11 & under
  - B – Handicapped Youth Age 12 & over
8. Merchandise Prizes paid 1:6. Merchandise prizes will be awarded to the adult and the youth not to exceed \$500 based on the number of entries in the division.
9. Re-entries will be allowed, but you may only be listed on the prize list once with your highest finish. If you are in multiple categories for the same amount, your scratch finish places first, then your age division places next.
10. Any disputes will be decided by the tournament director or MTCUSBC Board assignee. All decisions made by the tournament director are final.
